

Kindly amend the above-identified trademark application as follows:

In the Application and the Drawing:

On page 1, line 4 in the Application, and in the Drawing, delete the identification of goods in Classes 7 and 12 in its entirety and substitute therefor, --

International Class 7

Car engine parts for sale to original equipment manufacturers, namely, ball bearings and roller bearings; connecting hoses for vehicle radiators for sale to original equipment manufacturers; exhaust pipes for land vehicles for sale to original equipment manufacturers.

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International Class 12

Engine, transmission and suspension parts for automobiles for sale to original equipment manufacturers; engine, transmission and suspension parts for aircraft, ships, railway cars and/or bicycles; transmission and suspension parts for automobiles for sale to original equipment manufacturers, namely, transmission drive gears, drive belts, rubber bumper covers, and safety dampers in the nature of shock absorbers for absorbing impact; transmission gears for sale to original equipment manufacturers; transmission bearings for sale to original equipment manufacturers; and rubber suspension bushings for sale to original equipment manufacturers. --

Delete the identification of goods in Class 17 in its entirety.

REMARKS


