FIFTH REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE OPPOSITION

Pursuant to 37 CFR §2.102, the undersigned potential opposer, Auto Supplies International Ltd. (f/k/a Mecatech UK Limited), through its counsel, respectfully requests an extension of time to file an opposition to the above-referenced application, which was published in the *Official Gazette* on May 28, 2002. Auto Supplies International Ltd. is a private limited company incorporated under the Companies Act 1985 of England and has its principal place of business in Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire, England.

This request is the fifth request for an extension made by potential opposer with respect to the above-referenced application. Pursuant to 37 CFR 2.102(c), the potential opposer is not permitted to receive additional extensions of time except under certain circumstances. Applicant's attorney, by means of an e-mail communication on October 21, 2002, has consented to this request for an extension of time for an additional period of thirty (30) days.


Potential opposer requests that the time for filing an opposition be extended for an additional period of thirty (30) days, to and including November 25, 2002. We, as counsel for the potential opposer, have contacted counsel for the applicant. We are in the process of negotiating specific details of a consent agreement between the parties that would resolve our concerns without the need for an opposition proceeding. Although we had expected the parties to reach agreement prior to this date, counsel for the applicant has indicated that she needs more time. We have urged applicant's counsel to provide comments to a draft consent agreement (that we provided on September 16, 2002) as soon as possible. We respectfully request that you find the foregoing to constitute good cause to grant this request for a fifth extension of time.

This request is made in triplicate, as required by 37 CFR §2.102(d).
