Oregon Central Credit Union, with an address at 336 N. E. 20th Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97232, respectfully requests a 90 day extension of time within which to oppose registration of the above identified mark. The current deadline for filing an opposition is August 22, 2002. If the present request is granted, the new due date for filing a Notice of Opposition will be November 20, 2002.

Additional time is necessary to investigate whether an opposition is necessary and to explore whether there might be possibilities of settlement with the applicant.

The showing of good cause for the additional 60 days beyond the first 30 days of the extension is as follows:


The potential opposer is hopeful of resolving the matter with the applicant in a manner which would result in an opposition not being filed, and it is believed that the

additional 60 days (for a total extension of 90 days) is necessary in order to allow adequate time to explore any such resolution possibilities.

The additional time request is believed would allow sufficient time for exploration of whether there might be settlement possibilities in this matter. Potential opposer submits that this is a sufficient showing of good cause to meet the requirements therefor.

This request is not made for the purposes of delay and favorable action is respectfully requested.




