Petitioner, Dionex Corporation, of Sunnyvale, California, through its undersigned attorney, hereby requests an additional 60-day extension of the opposition period, to and including September 7, 2001, in the subject trademark application published in the Official Gazette of April 10, 2001, at page TM 189.
