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

Applicant, Creative Gems & Jewelry Co., Ltd., a Thailand Corporation having a principal place of business located at 126/1 Topaz Tower, Krungthonburi Road, Banglampoolang Klongsarn, Bangkok 10600, Thailand, seeks a further two-month extension of time from September 13, 2002 to November 13, 2002 in which to file its Brief on Appeal. This is applicant's fourth request for an extension of time.

The trademark application at issue has been rejected by the Trademark Attorney under 15 U.S.C. § 1052(d) (1988). Applicant has appealed the trademark attorney's decision.

**Serial No. 75/918,264**

Applicant seeks this extension of time so that it can carry on its investigation of the cited registration. Research has indicated that the type of watches with which the mark is used are rugged timepieces using sporting and military settings sold through outlets specializing in knives, manicure sets and electronics. Because applicant is based in Thailand, correspondence with applicant is often slow, and applicant believes that the requested time will be necessary for the full development of the differences in goods and the outlets and channels of trade through which the registrant's grade are marketed.
