REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO OPPOSE

Pursuant to Trademark Rule 2.102, Hip Hop Beverage Corporation, a Nevada corporation, and its predecessor in interest, a California general partnership of Calvin Ross, James L. Robinson, and Bob Solomon (collectively, "Potential Opposers"), through their authorized attorney, request that they be granted two thirty (30) day extensions of time within which to file an opposition against applicant Ric Representacoes Importacao e Comercio Ltda. Corporation Brazil ("Applicant") regarding the mark "Pitbull and design". This mark was published for opposition in the Official Gazette of the United States Patent and Trademark Office on November 6, 2001, as Serial No. 76113989. The opposition period expires on December 6, 2001, and Potential Opposers request that two thirty day extensions be granted. The first, automatic, extension of time would extend the deadline to January 5, 2002, and the second extension of time would extend the deadline to February 4, 2002.

Good cause is shown for the second extension of time on two bases. First, Potential Opposers and Applicant have recently commenced negotiations to resolve this

matter without the need for formal proceedings in the Patent and Trademark Office, and the extension requested herein will give the parties a reasonable period of time within which to bring such negotiations to a conclusion. Second, in connection with such negotiations and in preparation for a possible opposition, Potential Opposers require extended time in which to investigate the above application and the claims asserted by Applicant in the course of negotiations, with a view to determining appropriate ways of protecting Potential Opposers' mark and the propriety of filing a Notice of Opposition.

This request for extension is made in good faith and not for the purpose of unnecessary delay. It is respectfully requested that both extensions, for a total extension of sixty (60) days, be granted.


