I. INTRODUCTION

1. Opposer respectfully requests the Board's admission of this Reply. Opposer requests a thirty day extension to file formal opposition to the mark "Fund Pilot", as published in the "Official Gazette" January 08, 2002. The thirty-day extension starts March 08, 2002 and ends April 08, 2002.


