Hair combs; bathing sponges and sponges for applying body powder and make-up; containers for household and kitchen, not of precious metal; electric toothbrushes; dishes, namely, glassware, porcelain and earthenware for household and kitchen; trivets for bowls and carafes in Class 21. REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE OPPOSITION
