FURTHER REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Dear Sir or Madam:

Minnesota Wild Hockey Club, LP, a limited partnership organized under the laws of the state of Minnesota, the sole general partner of which is Naegele Sports, LLC, a Minnesota limited liability company and having a principal place of business at 317 Washington Street, St. Paul, MN 55102-1609, hereby requests that the Board grant an additional thirty (30) day extension of time to file a Notice of Opposition in the above-referenced matter. Minnesota Wild Hockey Club, LP, has previously been granted an initial thirty (30) day extension to file a Notice of Opposition.

Minnesota Wild Hockey Club, LP has good cause pursuant to 37 CFR § 2.102(c); TBMP § 207.02 to request an additional extension. The extension is necessary in order for Minnesota Wild Hockey Club, LP, to further investigate and evaluate the grounds to be asserted in a Notice of Opposition. Applicant has filed twenty-six (26) related trademark applications, the parties are involved in multiple (now consolidated) opposition proceedings already before the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board and the parties are involved in litigation over the same trademark in the United States District Court for the District of Minnesota. Accordingly, evaluating the current trademark application is complex and requires additional time to be adequately conducted and completed. In the ongoing federal litigation between the parties the Court, on July 26, 2002, issued a twenty-six page Memorandum Opinion and Order on cross motions for summary judgment and we require additional time to analyze the impact of that decision on any potential opposition proceeding.
