AMENDMENT TO IDENTIFICATION OF GOODS**

Applicant requests that its present application, which was Published April 23, 2002, be amended by adding the following phrase to the Identification of Goods in Int. Classes 14 and 25:

-- , all of the aforementioned goods not for sports purposes --.

Accordingly, the complete Identification of Goods in Int. Classes 14 and 25 shall be as follows:

Women's clothing, namely, suits, dresses, skirts, blouses, slacks, pants, jackets, coats, rainwear, sweaters, vests, shorts, culottes, playsuits, bandeaux, halters, sashes, scarves, hats, gloves, belts, hosiery, socks, tights, pantyhose, knee-highs and shoes, all of the aforementioned goods not for sports purposes (Int. Class 25).--.

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
REMARKS

Applicant has submitted the above Amendment to the Identification of Goods pursuant to an understanding reached between Applicant and the Potential Opposer, ELAN, družba za ustanavljanje, financiranje in upravljanje z drugimi družbami d.d., a Slovenian joint stock company, located and doing business at Dunajska C. 160. 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia. The Amendment to the Identification of Goods in Int. Classes 14 and 25 narrows the scope of the present application by specifying "...all of the aforementioned goods not for sports purposes."




