Applicant's most recent request for an extension of time, filed August 9, 2007, is noted. It is further noted that on May 30, 2006 applicant filed her appeal brief, and that, since August 21, 2006 (after applicant's brief was forwarded to the Examining Attorney for preparation of his appeal brief), applicant has been requesting extensions of time so that she can provide color copies of exhibits to her appeal brief. Applicant has requested the extensions because of various health issues.

It is not clear that the exhibits which she wishes to submit in color were ever made of record during prosecution of the application, and therefore whether they may be

considered at all. Further, it is not clear whether color copies would have any relevance to the grounds for the final refusal, which are that the drawing is a material alteration of the original drawing, that the drawing contains more than one mark, and that the drawing and the specimen do not agree.

In view of the question about the admissibility and relevance of the color exhibits, and the fact that the appeal has been pending for three years, applicant's most recent request for an extension of time is granted, but **NO FURTHER EXTENSIONS** will be granted. The Board is sympathetic to applicant's various health problems, but the appeal cannot remain pending indefinitely. Applicant is allowed until **November 15, 2007** to submit the exhibits, failing which the application will be forwarded to the Examining Attorney for preparation of his appeal brief.
