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**PETITION TO REVIVE**

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Applicant Prema Jyothi Light hereby appeals to the Petitions Office for Revival of the Trademark Registration Application for the above-mentioned Mark, as per 37 CFR §2.66. Applicant is filing this PETITION without the assistance of an attorney.

1. **Background**

Final Refusal for this Mark was emailed to Applicant on 01-19-05, but Applicant's records indicated a later surface mailing date also. Therefore she thought she

had until August 9, 2005, to send in the NOTICE OF APPEAL. Further, she had difficulty affording the Appeal fee.

However, on August 8, 2005, she did send in a REQUEST FOR PERMISSION TO APPEAL at this later date, along with a NOTICE OF APPEAL dated August 8, 2005, and a check for \$100.

Applicant later received a letter from paralegal Angela Campbell with the TTAB, with a stated mailing date of August 18, 2005, explaining that since she had missed the deadline of 6 months from the emailing date of January 19, 2005 of the Final Refusal, which would have been July 19, 2005, regardless of the surface mailing date, her Trademark application was deemed abandoned.

Applicant does not wish to abandon this application! She sincerely requests that this application be revived, to enable her to file an Appeal to the TTAB.

Therefore, Applicant is now filing this PETITION TO REVIVE her application.

2. **Missed deadline for response was unintentional.**

Applicant inadvertently missed the Trademark Office's deadline for filing the Notice of Appeal. She hereby affirms that this was unintentional, in accordance with the requirements of 37 CFR §2.66.

3. **This Petition is timely.**

This PETITION TO REVIVE is timely, as it is being submitted within two months of the notice of abandonment, which would be Ms. Campbell's letter dated

August 18, 2004, notifying her that her application was deemed abandoned, and that her NOTICE OF APPEAL could not be accepted.

4. **Awaiting refund of Appeal fee.**


However, her check for \$100 for the Appeal fee, which had accompanied her NOTICE OF APPEAL, had already been cashed by the Trademark Office, so she is now awaiting the refund of this fee, so that she can apply the funds to the new Appeal fee.

5. **Request to grant this PETITION TO REVIVE.**

Therefore, Applicant respectfully requests that this Petition to Revive be granted for the above-mentioned Mark, permitting her to refile a Notice of Appeal to the TTAB. This would allow her to file a brief with the TTAB, to enable the TTAB to review the Final Refusal, and hopefully grant Registration to this worthy and very excellent Mark, for the benefit of the public.
