Letter to the TTAB

Amendment to the Request for Extension of Time to Send Exhibits

This is an Amendment to the Request for Extension of Time submitted via ESTTA on February 7, 2007.

I am happy to announce that funds are coming through which will enable me to travel to Virginia, to get the needed samples for the PTO trademark hearings directly out of my storage area there!

Some back payments for federal disability assistance were awarded to me but not yet paid, and I have tried to get some of these funds released to me early so that I could come out to Virginia and rescue the needed copies of my works for TTAB review. Half of the funds needed for this trip have just arrived and the other half should arrive this week or next.

As finances are still tight, I cannot do an immediate airline ticket without the air fare being about quadruple what it would be with some advance notice.

Request is therefore being made to extend the deadline for submission of these samples just one more month, so that they are due in to the TTAB by April 11, 2007. (April 6 falls on Good Friday, so this new date would fall just after Easter Sunday.)

When I submitted the Request for Extension of Time on February 6, 2007, I thought that a trip to Virginia was financially impossible. But, doors have opened, and I am delighted at the opportunity to fly out and get the needed publication samples directly out of storage. It seems like a miracle, to be able to do this.

I am doing the best that I can, under difficult circumstances, to get everything needed into the hands of the TTAB judges so that they can make the best, and most well-informed, decisions on my trademark cases. I am flying out to Virginia with a still-injured foot and hand, but a happy heart.

While I am in Virginia, I can also rescue treasured photos of my mother, who has passed away, and other treasured photos. Such photos are not things which can ever be repurchased, so I am quite glad to be going out there. I can also retrieve copies of all of my other works, and many original illustrations and snowflakes. This rescues them from loss, as I am overdue on payments to the storage area.

This letter is an Amendment to the Request for Extension of Time submitted on February 6, 2007, incorporating new information about the arrival of funds to make the trip out to Virginia to retrieve the needed samples for TTAB review.

I would be hugely grateful for your kindness in granting this request, and delighted to get the needed color samples on out to you. Thank you and God bless you!
