By the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board:

Applicant's communication, filed March 4, 2011, is noted.

Applicant states that all requests for both of the above-identified applications have been submitted simultaneously, apparently in response to the statement made in the Board's March 2, 2011 order that the no alternative claim of acquired distinctiveness is in the file in Application Serial No. 76923326. The Board recognizes, as stated in that order, that applicant was apparently attempting to assert such a claim, but the pdf attachment to her response/request filed on December 15, 2009 was in fact not attached. Therefore, if applicant wishes to pursue this request, she should simply refile the paper that she had previously intended to attach.

Applicant also has requested a six month extension of time in which to submit additional specimens, stating that she must move out of her current location because of death threats, and that it may take her that amount of time to find other housing. She has indicated that people who are threatening her are able to find her location because of her filings in the USPTO because the records are publicly available. The Board notes that applicant has obtained extensions of time for years (applicant's first request for an extension of time to submit exhibits/specimens) was filed August 21, 2006). Reasons for these extensions have included that applicant had to move locations, that applicant had been injured and time was needed to recover, and even the threats that applicant has referenced in her current request. Given the totality of the circumstances, the Board finds that a six month extension of time is not warranted. Applicant is allowed **three months** from the mailing date of this order in which to file any specimens that she wishes to submit in Application Serial Nos. 76923326 and 76923327, and to submit the amendment in the alternative to claim acquired distinctiveness in Application Serial No. 76923326. **No further extensions for any reason will be granted.**
