Massachusetts, hereby respectfully requests that the time for filing a Notice of Opposition against the above application be extended for a further period of thirty (30) days.


The undersigned attorney for potential Opposer has been in further contact with counsel for Applicant regarding resolution of this matter. Further discussions are expected to take place this week.

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
