This Office action is in response to applicant's communication filed on 8/15/08.

The refusal under Trademark Act Section 2(e)(1) is now made FINAL for the reasons set forth below. See 15 U.S.C. §1052(e)(1); 37 C.F.R. §2.64(a).

The examining attorney maintains that the proposed mark is incapable of serving as a source-identifier for applicant's goods and/or services. Therefore, the refusal of registration under Section 2(e)(1) is *continued*, notwithstanding applicant's claim of acquired distinctiveness under Section 2(f), 15 U.S.C. §1052(f).

The proposed wording "SCHOLARSHIPS.COM" is generic because it consists of a generic term SCHOLARSHIPS combined with the top-level domain (TLD) COM, and is therefore generic for applicant's services, thus unregistrable based on Section 2(f). The TLD will be perceived by prospective customers as part of an Internet address, denoting an electronic commerce service and, therefore, has no source identifying significance. *In re Martin Container, Inc.*, 65 USPQ2d 1058 (TTAB 2002) ("[T]o the average customer seeking to buy or rent containers, "CONTAINER.COM" would immediately indicate a commercial web site on the Internet which provides containers.").

Relying on *In re Steelbuing.com*, 415 F.3d 1293, 1422 (Fed Cir. 2005), the applicant argues that the term SCHOLARSHIPS.COM, at most, may lead consumers to the conclusion that applicant's goods or services are somehow related to scholarships, but is not understood primarily to refer to information services. Applicant contends that the addition of .com does not render the mark generic but gives the

mark an entirely new meaning. However, this case is unlike the facts in *Steelbuilding .com* wherein *Steelbuilding.com* was determined not to be generic for a variety of reasons. The services in *Steelbuilding.com* is "computerized on-line services in the field of pre-engineered metal buildings and roofing systems wherein the applicant among other things offered interactive design features that allows customers to design, calculate price for, and purchase their own unique designs in addition. Since applicant's goods were not limited to the narrow genus of steel buildings, and since there was no evidence that steelbuilding is used as a composite word, or the joining of steel and building would create a generic term, the addition of the top level domain name .com, in this case, expanded the meaning which went beyond the sale of steel buildings. Here, the services are purely information services, there is no combining of two words to form a composite and consumers are familiar with the wording scholarships.

The facts in this case are similar to those in *In re CyberFinancial.Net Inc.*, 65 USPQ2d 1789 (TTAB 2002), wherein the Board found that "BONDS.COM" is generic for applicant's information and electronic commerce services regarding financial products provided via Internet, since Bonds is the name of one of the financial products that comprise the subject matter of the services, and thus is generic for the information services and electronic commerce services. Here, the applicant provides "online scholarship and financial aid information services." As demonstrated by the wording in the recitation of services, the key focus of applicant's online information service is "scholarships." Applicant, *Scholarship.com* is a company that offers a free database of more than 600,000 scholarships. See Incoming mail 5/17/07 page 234. The examining attorney previously made of record the definitions of .com, scholarships and dot com. See attachments for additional definitions.

It seems clear that the subject matter of applicant's information service, whether identified as financial aid information or scholarship information, is scholarships. The board has held in the past that a term which is the generic name of a particular category of goods is likewise generic for any services that are directed to or focused on that class of goods. See: *In re Log Cabin Homes Ltd.*, 52 USPQ2d 1206 (TTAB 1999) [because LOG CABIN HOMES is generic for a particular type of building, it is also generic for architectural design services directed to that type of building, and for retail outlets featuring kits for construction of that kind of building]; *In re Harcourt Brace Jonavich, Inc.* 222 USPQ 820 (TTAB 1984) [LAW & BUSINESS incapable of distinguishing applicant's services of arranging and conducting seminars in the field of business law]; *Hotels.com, L.P.*, 87 USPQ2d 1100 (TTAB, 2008). [HOTELS.COM incapable of distinguishing services of information about temporary lodging and making reservations therefore]

Generic terms are terms that the relevant purchasing public understands primarily as the common or class name for the goods or services. *In re Dial-A-Mattress Operating Corp.*, 240 F.3d 1341, 57 USPQ2d 1807 (Fed. Cir. 2001); *In re American Fertility Society*, 188 F.3d 1341, 51 USPQ2d 1832 (Fed. Cir. 1999); *In re Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc.*, 828 F.2d 1567, 4 USPQ2d 1141 (Fed. Cir. 1987); *H. Marvin Ginn Corp. v. Int'l Ass'n of Fire Chiefs, Inc.*, 782 F.2d 987, 228 USPQ 528 (Fed. Cir. 1986). Generic terms are by definition incapable of indicating a particular source of the goods or services, and cannot be registered as trademarks; doing so "would grant the owner of the mark a monopoly, since a competitor could not describe his goods as what they are." *In re Merrill Lynch*, 828 F.2d at 1569, 4 USPQ2d at 1142.

A two-part test is used to determine whether a designation is generic:

- (1) What is the class or genus of goods or services at issue?
- (2) Does the relevant public understand the designation primarily to refer to that class or genus of goods or services?

See *H. Marvin Ginn Corp. v. International Ass'n of Fire Chiefs, Inc.*, 782 F.2d 987, 228 USPQ 528 (Fed. Cir. 1986); TMEP §1209.01(c)(i).

With respect to the first part of the genericness inquiry, the class or category of services is information services regarding scholarships, offered via the Internet.

As to the second part of the genericness inquiry, the examining attorney previously made of record evidence to show that scholarship.com refer to the category of services at issue, namely, information and electronic commerce services regarding scholarships. The examining attorney previously made of record evidence from the examining attorney search in an on line computer database shows that the proposed mark SCHOLARSHIP.COM is incapable as used in connection with online services in the field of information concerning scholarships and financial aid because consumers are used to looking for scholarship information on line, and are familiar with seeing a variety of references to scholarships on websites containing scholarship.com as part of the website address. See attachments to the Office actions dated 4/01/06, 11/16/06, and 6/29/07 and to this Office action. The applicant argues that the examining attorney has not met requirements for the test for genericness.

However, the examining attorney maintains that those providing online information services involving scholarships would need to use and are entitled to use the generic terms in connection with such services. The principal significance of the term "SCHOLARSHIPS.COM" to the average person is "online information services in the field of scholarships. Consumers are used to looking for scholarship information on line, and familiar with seeing a variety of references to scholarships on websites containing scholarship.com or scholarships.com as part of the website address. See examples below and attachments to the Office action mailed 6/29/07.

A search of the terms scholarships and/or scholarship websites provide many links to online websites that provide information about scholarships and in some cases an opportunity for a potential consumer to apply for a scholarship online. The evidence of record clearly establishes that SCHOLARSHIPS.COM is a common term for applicant's information service, specifically online scholarship information. Nothing unusual, incongruous or unexpected results from this mark. "SCHOLARSHIPS.COM" is generic term for applicant's information services regarding scholarships via Internet, since "scholarship" is name of a grant of financial aid awarded to a student that comprises the subject matter of applicant's services, and thus is SCHOLARSHIP.COM is the generic name for applicant's information services. Web site and promotional materials along with the wording in the recitation of services demonstrate that the key focus of applicant's services is scholarships. It is reasonable to conclude that applicant's mark consists of a generic designation describing the subject matter of applicant's information service. The addition of the well known top-level domain indicates only that applicant is a commercial entity and that the services provided by applicant involves the Internet. Thus, the proposed mark is generic as applied to applicant's services.

In the alternative, the applicant has claimed section 2(f). The 2(f) evidence proffered by the applicant among other things consists of the declaration of Lawrence A. Gerber, Managing Director of Scholarships.com, LLC, ("applicant") and evidence that purportedly support the declaration. The declaration consists of a statement that over the past nine years, applicant has regularly advertised its website for third party scholarships and financial aid opportunities under its marks SCHOLARSHIPS.COM and SCHOLARSHIPS.COM and Design through various methods, including (i) the purchase of keywords at both www.google.com and www.yahoo.com; (ii) the placement of strategic Internet banners on websites located at www.collegejournal.com; and www.careerjournal.com; and (iii) semi-annual mass marketing campaigns where approximately 25,000 letters and brochures are sent to various scholarship providers, and approximately 25,000 letters and postcards are sent to every high school and college in the United States. The applicant notes that applicant is a member and sponsor of three prestigious educational and financial aid organizations, including the National Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators (NASFAA), the National Scholarship Providers Association (NSPA), and The National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC). Applicant indicates that its employees annually attend conferences through these organizations, at which Applicant heavily publicizes its services under its marks SCHOLARSHIPS.COM and SCHOLARSHIPS.COM and Design, with indoor and outdoor signage, marketing brochures, and other marketing materials. Applicant also indicates that applicant advertises its marks with outdoor signage on various large university campuses, such as the University of Illinois. The declaration also states applicant has spent over 275,000 solely for the marketing and promotion of applicant's services offered under the SCHOLARSHIPS.COM mark and SCHOLARSHIPS.COM and Design mark. Finally, the declaration mentions the media coverage referencing applicant's mark, gross sales and the number of visitors to applicant's site per day. Taken as a whole, the 2(f) evidence does not mean that the mark has achieved distinctiveness. It demonstrates the success of the applicant's information services, but not that relevant consumers have

come to view SCHOLARSHIPS.COM as applicant's mark. Further, there is no evidence that relevant consumers understand the difference in concept between brand name and domain name.

The applicant has made references to various third party registrations which have issued with far less, if any Section 2(f) evidence. 1994). Applicant should note the following. Third-party registrations are not conclusive on the question of descriptiveness. Each case must be considered on its own merits. A proposed mark that is merely descriptive does not become registrable simply because other similar marks appear on the register. *In re Scholastic Testing Service, Inc.*, 196 USPQ 517 (TTAB 1977); TMEP §1209.03(a). The applicant should also note that some the reference registrations pre-date the decisions concerning generic designations and upper level domain names.

The amount and character of evidence needed to establish acquired distinctiveness depends on the facts of each case and particularly on the nature of the mark sought to be registered. *Roux Labs., Inc. v. Clairol Inc.*, 427 F.2d 823, 829, 166 USPQ 34, 39 (C.C.P.A. 1970); see *In re Hehr Mfg. Co.*, 279 F.2d 526, 126 USPQ 381 (C.C.P.A. 1960); TMEP §1212.05(a).

More evidence is required where a mark is so highly descriptive that purchasers seeing the matter in relation to the named goods and/or services would be less likely to believe that it indicates source in any one party. See, e.g., *In re Bongrain Int'l Corp.*, 894 F.2d 1316, 13 USPQ2d 1727 (Fed. Cir. 1990); *In re Seaman & Assocs., Inc.*, 1 USPQ2d 1657 (TTAB 1986).

However, no amount of purported proof that a generic term has acquired secondary meaning can transform that term into a registrable trademark. Such a designation cannot become a trademark under any circumstances. See *In re Bongrain*, 894 F.2d at 1317 n.4, 13 USPQ2d at 1728 n.4; *H. Marvin Ginn Corp. v. Int'l Ass'n of Fire Chiefs, Inc.*, 782 F.2d 987, 989, 228 USPQ 528, 530 (Fed. Cir. 1986); TMEP §1212.02(i).

The examining attorney maintains that "SCHOLARSHIPS.COM" is generic within the mean of Section 2 (e)(1) of the Trademark Act, 15 U.S.C. 1052(e)(1) and that applicant's claim of acquired distinctiveness under Trademark Act Section 2(f) is insufficient because the proposed mark is generic, or in the alternative, so highly descriptive that the applicant's showing of acquired distinctiveness is unpersuasive. The applicant previously submitted a Request for Reconsideration with a Notice of Appeal. The Board will be notified to resume the appeal.






A vast majority of students (I'm talking over 90%, at least) make stupid mistakes that disqualify their essays almost immediately. At first, it made me laugh (you know, in the "Man, these kids today..." sense), but soon enough it became a little depressing. I'd have a stack of scholarship essays that would take me hours to read, and it was exhausting to think that only a handful of them would be winner material. To be honest, it also hacked me off at the educational system. Is there really no one out there teaching our high school students how to write an acceptable scholarship essay?

Apparently not. So I decided to do something about it. I wrote a short e-book on the subject, which was very helpful for the kids who bought it, but didn't do much for the body of applicants as a whole. So I decided to put this website out there for everyone to use, for free. If you'd still like to have all the information from the site in one document, you can still buy and instantly download the book if you want. But if you're willing to explore this website, you don't have to.

The Robert A. Shuker Scholarship Fund was established in 1993, to honor the late Judge Robert A. Shuker, Associate Judge of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia. Its primary purpose is to find and assist young people in obtaining an education that have few financial resources, but a burning desire to learn, achieve, and serve the public. Robert A. Shuker was an extraordinary lawyer, an outstanding judge, and a remarkable person. He was a man with an unmatched combination of courage, intellect, wisdom, and integrity. Although from an impoverished background, Judge Shuker believed in education, and that through education one could achieve any goal. Thus, he worked during his school years at many different jobs, and with scholarship assistance, ultimately achieved his aspirations first by becoming a lawyer and later a judge. Throughout his life, even in the most difficult times, he never lost his compassion for other human beings, his love of life, his distinctive wit, or his special sense of humor.

Judge Robert A. Shuker was born April 28, 1941, in Needham, Massachusetts. He graduated from Brown University with an A.B. degree in June 1963 and the University of Chicago Law School, with a J.D. degree in June 1966. From 1966 to 1968, he worked as a Trial Lawyer for the Chicago Lawyer Project, funded by the Ford Foundation, representing indigent juveniles. In 1968, he joined the Office of the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, rising to the position of Chief, Superior Court Division. While with the Office of the United States Attorney, he led the prosecution team in the well-known Hanafi Muslim murder case, one of the most complex and difficult cases ever prosecuted in the United States Attorney's Office.

Judge Robert A. Shuker was the first recipient of the United States Attorney's Office's Harold J. Sullivan Award, presented for his dedication and self-sacrifice, courage and intelligence, personal empathy and professional fairness that best exemplified the career and life of Harold J. Sullivan.

He was sworn in as an Associate Judge of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia on June 1, 1977, and remained on the bench until his death on June 28, 1993.





The scholarship was established soon after Warren Cherry's untimely death in 1990. Warren was a charismatic educator and community leader. He lived the Golden Rule and worked relentlessly to create equity and balance in services and access. He was widely known and respected; his impact was extraordinary. It is less widely known that "Billy" (as he was known by his ETHS classmates, friends, and family), though popular and active in high school, was not a serious student. Few recognized then his tremendous potential to lead and to help others realize *their* potential.

"Billy" Cherry went to barber school after graduation and had a brief career as a barber before enrolling at Trinidad Jr. College in Trinidad, Colorado. His education culminated with completion of coursework toward a Ph.D. at Northwestern University. Warren's service to the Evanston/Skokie community included teaching at Timber Ridge School and serving as Associate Principal of Skiles Middle School (now Martin Luther King Lab School) and Principal of Central and Lincoln Schools. He served on the boards of the ETHS Boosters Club, the Girl Scouts, the Justin Wynn Memorial Fund, the Mental Health Association, the United Way, and the McGaw YMCA and was
