On June 7, 2007, applicant filed an unsigned notice of appeal and amendment.

Applicant is advised that TBMP §1202.03 (2d ed. rev. 2004) provides that although the notice of appeal must be signed, an unsigned notice of appeal will not be refused consideration if a signed copy is submitted to the Board within the time limit set in the notification of this defect by the Board.

Accordingly, applicant is allowed until **twenty days** from the date hereof in which to submit a signed copy of its notice of appeal. Upon receipt of a signed notice, the

notice of appeal will be instituted and the application will be remanded to the Examining Attorney for consideration of the amendment.
