AMENDMENT

conducting of educational and entertainment conventions, assemblies, conferences, seminars, exhibitions, meetings and training workshops in the field of philanthropic, humanitarian and service activities; providing online information in the field of education and entertainment, namely providing on-line training and educational materials through an e-learning center on the subject of philanthropic, humanitarian and service activities and providing on-line information about conventions, conferences, assemblies, workshops and related club activities; language translation of books, magazines, brochures, pamphlets and training manuals; vocational guidance; written text editing”, in International Class 41.
