**REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION

Pursuant to TBMP § 1203.02, and for good cause shown, Host Hotels & Resorts, L.P. ("Applicant") respectfully requests that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board extend its time to file an appeal brief for thirty (30) days, up to and including **May 16, 2008.**
