Applicant's notice of appeal, request to divide, and request for reconsideration, filed June 26, 2008, are noted.

On July 15, 2008, the Intent to Use Division of the Office completed applicant's request to divide the application. The goods and/or services in International Class 45 have been placed in the newly created child application, Serial No. 77975745. Inasmuch as the goods and/or services in class 45 are not the subject of the instant appeal, jurisdiction is restored to the Examining Attorney for further appropriate action.

The goods and/or service in International Class 35 remain in the original application, Serial No. 77147075. Inasmuch as the goods and/or service in class 35 are the
