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## REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION DENIED

**ISSUE/MAILING DATE:** 10/1/2010

Applicant is requesting reconsideration of a final refusal issued/mailed February 4, 2010. The final refusal contained an explanation regarding "naked consent" agreements. Applicant states that the consent agreement is confidential and referenced some of the language contained in the agreement in its request for reconsideration. However, the request for reconsideration does not include any portions of the consent agreement.

After careful consideration of the law and facts of the case, the examining attorney must deny the request for reconsideration and adhere to the final action as written since no new facts or reasons have been presented that are significant and compelling with regard to the point at issue.

Accordingly, applicant's request for reconsideration is *denied*. The time for appeal runs from the date the final action was issued/mailed. 37 C.F.R. §2.64(b); TMEP §715.03(c). If applicant has already filed a timely notice of appeal, the application will be forwarded to the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board (TTAB).
