By way of its communication, applicant requests that the first, second, and third requests for an extension of time to file a notice of opposition be rescinded because potential opposer failed to comply with Trademark Rule 2.101, the rule governing notices of opposition filed on or after November 1, 2007.

Respectively, applicant is advised that Trademark Rule
2.101 applies to filing of a notice of opposition, and not to
a request to extend time to file a notice of opposition.

For information regarding proof of service of a request to extend time to file a notice of opposition, applicant's attention is directed to the Trademark Board Manual of Procedure, TBMP § 203.04 (2nd ed. rev. June 2004), which states in pertinent part:

Inasmuch as a request for an extension of time to oppose is a paper filed prior to the commencement of the opposition, it is ex parte, rather than inter partes, in nature. Accordingly, the request need not include proof of service upon the applicant.

In view thereof, applicant's request to rescind potential opposer's requests to extend time to file a notice of opposition is denied. Accordingly, potential opposer, The Worlds Pageants, LLC is allowed until June 5, 2011, in which to file a notice of opposition, if it so desires.
