18 Pursuant to the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board Manual of Procedure, ("TBMP"), Sections
19 201, *et seq.*, SBO PICTURES, INC., a California corporation, Opposer, hereby files this Request for

07649-1512, telephone (201) 599-0588, the attorney of record for the Applicant, Robert Delsole, an


1 individual, 86 Valley Road, Larchmont, New York, 10538-1523, telephone (914) 834-9198. Mr. Joel

4 Pursuant to TBMP, § 201, and 37 Code of Federal Regulations, ("CFR"), § 2.102(c), Opposer
5 asserts good cause for the extension of time as follows: Opposer is investigating facts of the matter, and
6 whether there may be an informal settlement resolution of the matter in order to avoid a formal TTAB
