REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO OPPOSE

On March 24, 2003, National Foundation for Credit Counseling, Inc. of Silver Spring, Maryland, requested an extension of time of sixty days to file a Notice of Opposition against the above-identified application. That request would extend the filing deadline from April 3, 2003 to June 2, 2003. Potential Opposer mistakenly indicated, however, that the new filing date would be May 3, 2003. Potential Opposer is filing this corrected request to clarify that its original request sought a sixty day extension, namely, through June 2, 2003.


In the alternative, to the extent that the Board will grant only a 30 day extension of the original filing deadline based on potential Opposer's March 24, 2003 request, potential Opposer requests that the Board grant an additional 30 day extension of the opposition filing deadline, to and including June 2, 2003. The extension is needed to provide the potential Opposer and its counsel time to consider the matter, gather information, and possibly confer with the Applicant so that potential Opposer can decide

whether to file an opposition. This request is for good cause and is not filed for the purpose of mere delay, and favorable consideration is requested. Pursuant to Rule 2.102(d), this request is submitted in triplicate.
