60 Day Request for Extension of Time to Oppose Upon Extraordinary Circumstances

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. Section 2.102, Lam Research Corporation, 4650 Cushing Parkway, Fremont, CA 94538, UNITED STATES respectfully requests that he/she/it be granted an additional 60-day extension of time to file a notice of opposition against the above-identified mark for extraordinary circumstances shown .

Potential opposer believes that extraordinary circumstances are established for this request by:

- Applicant and potential Opposer are presently parties to a number of oppositions or potential oppositions in a number of different countries, including Switzerland, Germany, Ireland, and the UK, all arising out of the same mark that is the subject of Applicant#s US Application Serial No. 78663662. Potential Opposer has corresponded with Applicant#s US counsel, suggesting that the parties enter into a worldwide mutual co-existence agreement rather than expending valuable time and resources in numerous international oppositions, and setting forth proposed terms for such an agreement. In its correspondence, potential Opposer requested that Applicant consent to an additional extension of time of ninety (90) days to enable the parties to enter into negotiations, which potential Opposer believes is reasonable given that Applicant is located in Japan, and that any such negotiations will involve the resolution of numerous actions in various other countries. Indeed, potential Opposer has obtained or requested similar extensions of time in the afore-referenced international actions to similarly allow the parties to conduct a single negotiation. Applicant has not responded to potential Opposer#s correspondence, nor to its request for extension of time. Accordingly, potential Opposer requests this additional sixty (60) day extension of time to continue to investigate additional avenues of negotiation and resolution, including the possible commencement of negotiations outside of the US.

The time within which to file a notice of opposition is set to expire on 07/19/2006. Lam Research Corporation respectfully requests that the time period within which to file an opposition be extended until 09/17/2006.
