Applicant's request to remand filed March 21, 2011 is noted. Applicant seeks remand in order for the Examining Attorney to consider a consent agreement. Good cause having been shown, the request for remand is granted, action on the appeal is suspended, and the file is remanded to the Trademark Examining Attorney for consideration of the consent agreement.

If the consent agreement is accepted and the mark is found registrable on the basis of this paper, the appeal will be moot. If the request is accepted but the refusal to register is maintained, the Examining Attorney should issue an Office Action so indicating, and return the file to the

Board. The appeal will then be resumed and an oral hearing will be rescheduled accordingly.
