**REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION DENIED**

**ISSUE/MAILING DATE: 3/21/2011**

The trademark examining attorney has carefully reviewed applicant's request for reconsideration and is denying the request for the reasons stated below. *See* 37 C.F.R. §2.64(b); TMEP §§715.03(a), 715.04(a). Because Applicant has assigned its application to the owner of the cited registrations, the refusal for likelihood of confusion is withdrawn. However, the refusal(s) under Section 2(e)(4) made final in the Office action dated August 27, 2010 are maintained and continue to be final. *See* TMEP §§715.03(a), 715.04(a).

In the present case, applicant's request has not resolved all the outstanding issue(s), nor does it raise a new issue or provide any new or compelling evidence with regard to the outstanding issue(s) in the final Office action. In addition, applicant's analysis and arguments are not persuasive nor do they shed new light on the issues. Accordingly, the request is denied.

A. Recognized Meaning in Another Language

Applicant argues that the proposed mark CAVALLI has a recognized meaning in another language because it is the Italian word for "horses", and therefore, is not *primarily* a surname. *See In re Isabella Fiore LLC*, 75 U.S.P.Q.2d 1564, 1568-69 (TTAB 2005)(holding that the term "FIORE" was not primarily merely a surname because it was the Italian word for flower). However, the doctrine of foreign equivalents is not an

absolute rule, but merely a guideline, which should be applied only when it is likely that the ordinary American purchaser would stop and translate the foreign word into its English equivalent. *See Palm Bay Imports, Inc. v. Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Maison Fondee en 1772*, 396 F.3d 1369, 73 USPQ2d 1689 (Fed. Cir. 2005). The “ordinary American purchaser” includes “all American purchasers, including those proficient in a non-English language who would ordinarily be expected to translate words into English.” *In re Spirits Int’l, N.V.*, 563 F.3d 1347, 1352, 90 USPQ2d 1489, 1492 (Fed. Cir. 2009). To support a refusal under §2(e)(4), the record must show that the surname significance is the *primary* significance. *See In re Picone*, 221 USPQ 93 (TTAB 1984) (evidence that “PICON” is the name of a town and a mountain in Spain and that “piccone” is an Italian word meaning “pick” or “pickax” insufficient to overcome a refusal on the ground that PICONE is *primarily* merely a surname). *See* TMEP §1211.01(a)(vii).

Applicant has concluded that “because ‘cavalli’ has a recognized meaning as the Italian word for ‘horses,’ the primary significance of the term to consumers is not that of a surname.” This is not the test. Not every term with a recognized meaning in the Italian language will have as its primary significance, the English translation of the Italian term. *See, In re Piccone*, *supra*. The test is whether the ordinary American purchaser would “stop and translate” the term into its English equivalent. In this case, unlike in *Fiore*, the surname CAVALLI is the surname of an individual associated with Applicant, namely, Roberto Cavalli, the founder, which is a significant factor in the analysis. *See In re Etablissements Darty et Fils*, 759 F.2d 15, 225 USPQ 652 (Fed. Cir. 1985); TMEP §1211.02(b)(iv).

In addition to the previously attached evidence the Examining Attorney attaches below and in Exhibit 1, several articles and web pages showing CAVALLI used in the media. Many of the media references are of the Applicant’s founder/owner. If a surname appears routinely in news reports, articles and other media as to be broadly exposed to the general public, then such surname is not rare and would be perceived by the public as primarily merely a surname. *In re Gregory*, 70 USPQ2d 1792, 1795 (TTAB 2004); *see* TMEP §1211.01(a)(v). Here, the surname CAVALLI will be used with the goods and services of Roberto Cavalli, the famous fashion designer. (See attached Exhibit 2 showing Roberto Cavalli referred to as famous). Because the services under the CAVALLI mark will be associated with Roberto Cavalli (See exhibit 3), consumers are not likely to stop and translate the term from its foreign language meaning and are likely to consider it primarily merely a surname.

#### B. Look and Feel of a Surname

Applicant also argues that the term “CAVALLI” looks and sounds more like an Italian word and would not be viewed as primarily merely a surname. This argument is unsupported. The surname, CAVALLI, contrary to “fiore” clearly has the look and feel of a surname. *In re Gregory*, 70 USPQ2d 1792, 1796 (TTAB 2004); *In re Industrie Pirelli Societa per Azioni*, 9 USPQ2d 1564, 1566 (TTAB 1988); *In re Petrin Corp.*, 231 USPQ 902, 904 (TTAB 1986); *see* TMEP §1211.01(a)(vi). In *In re Pirelli* *supra*, the Board determined that PIRELLI resembles some common Italian American surnames

such as Antonelli, Mancinelli and Pacelli in their structure and pronunciation. Applicant's surname CAVALLI also resembles PIRELLI and other Italian-American surnames. As evidence, the Examining Attorney has attached several examples of surnames from whitepages.com that are similar in structure and pronunciation to CAVALLI such as Carvelli, Caparelli, Pacelli, Cavall and Cavallo. (See attached Exhibit 4). Please see also the attached registrations for CAVALLI and PASCALLI under Section 2(f) and on the Supplemental Register.

For the foregoing reasons, the final refusal of application on the Principle Register under Section 2(e)(4) because the mark is primarily merely a surname is continued.

The filing of a request for reconsideration does not extend the time for filing a proper response to a final Office action or an appeal with the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board (Board), which runs from the date the final Office action was issued/mailed. *See* 37 C.F.R. §2.64(b); TMEP §§715.03, 715.03(a), (c).

If time remains in the six-month response period to the final Office action, applicant has the remainder of the response period to comply with and/or overcome any outstanding final requirement(s) and/or refusal(s) and/or to file an appeal with the Board. TMEP §715.03(a), (c). However, if applicant has already filed a timely notice of appeal with the Board, the Board will be notified to resume the appeal when the time for responding to the final Office action has expired. *See* TMEP §715.04(a).
