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On May 10, 2013, applicant filed a request to divide the subject application.

Proceedings in the appeal are suspended and the application is forwarded to the Intent to Use Division of the Office to consider the request to divide.

The Board notes that the final office action dated October 3, 2012, only pertained to class 9, which is subject to this appeal proceeding. Inasmuch as the request to divide will create a new application dividing out class(es) 7, 10, 35, 37, 38, 42 and 45 which are not subject to this appeal proceeding, if the request to divide is approved, the Intent to Use Division should forward the newly created

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"child" application to the Trademark Examining Attorney for further processing towards a registration.

Once the divisional request is completed, the Board should be notified so that appropriate action can be taken with respect to the "parent" application.
