Dear Sir or Madam,

In telephone conversations with the Denise Delgizzi of the Trademark Trial & Appeal Board on November 4, 2013, we confirmed that our June 25, 2013 Request for 90 Day Extension of Time to Oppose and our timely filed October 2013 Opposition are both being handled by Ms Millicent Canady. We were further informed that Ms Canady was scheduled to deny our Request for Extension of Time on the grounds it was not timely filed solely because the TTAB did not have record of receipt of the Request in June, even though we provided a valid Certificate of Service (Mailing) for the June 25, 2013 date.

Ms Delgizzi further confirmed that in such an instance where there is a valid Certificate of Service (Mailing) but where there is some question about the PTO/TTAB receiving the item, then Chapter 100 (more precisely, 110.01(b)(3)) of the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board Manual or Procedure indicates that the filing will be considered timely if there is a declaration of timely mailing made by the person who has personal knowledge of the mailing in question. In addition, we left messages for Mr McWilliams, whom we understand supervises Ms Canady, asking that Ms Canady please delay issuing her denial of our Request to give us time to file the attached declaration. We thus trust that she did delay her decision, and that thus this declaration is arriving in time for her to convert her decision to approval of our 90 Day Extension, as fairness requires. But in the event that

there is a cross over in communications and this letter and attachments arrives after Ms Canady has already issued a denial, then in that circumstance we ask that this letter be accepted as an Appeal of that decision based on the attached declaration proving that we did timely file the Request for Extension (which in turn means that our Opposition was indeed timely filed in October, too).

Please find attached the declaration of Cheri Langdell under TBMP 110.01(b)(3) to meet the requirement that the mailing of our Request for 90 Days Extension of Time to Oppose was timely filed on June 25, 2013. We note that Ms Langdell also attaches a copy of the actual version of the **First 90 Day Request for Extension of Time to Oppose for Good Cause** showing that it was valid, and was timely filed.

We note that Cheri Langdell's integrity and honesty have never been question, and hence her declaration should be accepted by the Board as acceptable to prove timely filing.

In turn, we trust that the Board can accept that our Opposition to the Registration of this mark was timely filed in October 2013, and, since you have already processed our \$600 fee for the Opposition, that now the mark can be placed back in pending, pre-registration status with the Opposition proceedings commenced.

First 90 Day Request for Extension of Time to Oppose for Good Cause




