In response to a Final Office Action from the Trademark Attorney dated April, 14<sup>th</sup> 2014, reconsideration of the application identified above is requested for the reasons stated in the following paragraphs.

**I. LIKELIHOOD OF CONFUSION – SECTION 2(D) REFUSAL**

In accordance with the sound, sight and meaning trilogy, the trademarks differ and are thus not confusingly similar.

The conflicting trademarks differ in terms of sound:

The trademarks contain the same number of syllables and are identical in the letters MOSHIK, but differ in the last vowel O in the prior trademark registration 3059115 and I in the trademark application which is subject of the Examiner's Office Action.

The vowel O is a *high-mid back rounded vowel*, which is characterized by positioning of the tongue halfway between a high vowel and a mid vowel. In contrast, I is a *high front unrounded vowel*. Its vowel height is closed, which means that the tongue is positioned as close as possible to the roof of the mouth. In terms of sound the vowels differ.

Accordingly, the trademarks differ in terms of sound, as the last syllabus which is dominated by the vowel O and/or I is clearly different.

The applicant has submitted with its response dated March 24, 2014 that the word MOSHI which the marks have in common is Japanese for “Hello”.

As the applicant already has pointed out the common element MOSHI of both trademarks is weak. If the common element of conflicting marks is a word that is “weak” then this reduces the likelihood of confusion. A portion of a mark may be “weak” in the sense that such portion is descriptive, highly suggestive, or is in common use by many other sellers in the market.<sup>1</sup>

Applicant wishes to draw Examiner’s attention to International Registration MOSCHINO IR No. 1199498. The trademark has been extended to US with Serial No. 79145623. The Examining attorney has searched the record and has found no conflict between MOSHIKO and MOSCHINO.

## **2. IDENTIFICATION OF GOODS**

Applicant has made the requested amendments to the identification of goods.

## **3. REQUEST FOR SUSPENSION OF ACTION**

Applicant respectfully submits that he has filed a petition to cancel registration No. 3059115 MOSHIKO on grounds of abandonment.

Applicant respectfully requests that the examiner suspends further action on the trademark application of trademark MOSHIKI No. 79132464 pending the decision of the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board in the cancelation proceedings.
