Applicant's request for remand of the above-entitled application to the Trademark Examining Attorney, filed on February 2, 2016, is noted.

Applicant seeks remand so that the Trademark Examining Attorney may review Applicant's proposed amendment to the involved application.¹ Because the Applicant's proposed amendment may avoid the refusal of registration, the good cause being established, the request for remand is hereby granted. However, amendment requires consideration by the Trademark Examining Attorney.

Accordingly, the appeal is suspended and the application file is remanded to the Trademark Examining Attorney for consideration of Applicant's proposed amendment.

If the Examining Attorney allows this application, the appeal will be moot and proceedings on the appeal will terminate in due course. If, however, the amendment is found unacceptable, the Examining Attorney should issue an Office Action indicating the reasons why the proposed amendment is unacceptable and notify the Board, which will then allow Applicant time to file its appeal brief.
