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MOTION TO REMAND

BEFORE THE TRADEMARK TRIAL AND APPEAL BOARD ON APPEAL

TRADEMARK EXAMINING ATTORNEY'S REQUEST FOR REMAND

The trademark examining attorney requests that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board remand this case to the trademark examining attorney under 37 C.F.R. §2.142(d) for the reason that follow.

Applicant has applied to register the mark ESLABONDEXX, in standard characters. Registration has been refused based upon a finding of a likelihood of confusion with the registered mark BONDEX, in standard characters (Registration No. 1507709) for “fingernail care products, namely fingernail primer” in International Class 03, pursuant to Section 2(d) of the Trademark Act.

On October 26, 2016, the trademark examining attorney contacted the applicant in an attempt to work out a resolution through an examiner's amendment. In an incoming e-mail correspondence dated October 26, 2016, applicant has agreed to amend the identification of goods in the application. As amended, the identification of goods identifies “bleaching preparations for use with hair; hair dyes; hair lotions; hair balsams; hair sprays; hair straightening preparations; hair waving preparations; cosmetics, namely, cosmetic preparations for the hair” in International Class 03.

Because the submitted amendment to the application resolves the outstanding issue and moots the appeal, the examining attorney requests remand of the application so that a subsequent examiner's amendment may be issued. *See* TBMP §1205.01 and TBMP §1209.02.
