**REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
FOR FILING APPLICANT-APPELLANT'S BRIEF**

TO THE TRADEMARK TRIAL AND APPEAL BOARD:

It is respectfully requested that the time now set for filing Applicant-Appellant's brief, August 16, 2013, be extended for an additional ninety (90) days, so that the brief will be due **January 13, 2014**, if at all. This request is not made for the purposes of delay, but for good cause, as Applicant-appellant is continuing to negotiate and receive an executed consent agreement via foreign counsel and considering a remand to the Examining Attorney. There are extenuating circumstances due to the great distance between the parties and their primary counsel which make negotiations take a longer period of time. The parties expect to be able to finalize a consent agreement toward the end of this year or beginning of next year. Accordingly, under the totality of the circumstances, good cause exists for this requested extension of time. Applicant-Appellant wishes to avoid the utilization of administrative resources in this appeal if indeed the consent agreement can be finalized, executed and submitted to the Office.

Applicant-appellant has made six (6) prior requests for extension, and respectfully requests that the time to file its brief be extended for additional ninety (90) days to afford Applicant-appellant time to obtain a consent agreement within the time anticipated by the parties or to prepare and file its brief, should it prove to be necessary.
