## **60 Day Request for Extension of Time to Oppose Upon Extraordinary Circumstances**

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. Section 2.102, GlenJ.Larson, 4775 Centennial Blvd., Suite 150, Colorado Springs, CO 80919, UNITED STATES respectfully requests that he/she/it be granted an additional 60-day extension of time to file a notice of opposition against the above-identified mark for extraordinary circumstances shown .

Potential opposer believes that extraordinary circumstances are established for this request by:

- Glen Larson requested the first two extensions under the belief that Applicant would be interested in entering a Coexistence Agreement. However, during the extended opposition period, there has been no indication that such an agreement will be executed between the parties despite Mr. Larson's efforts, which included sending Applicant's counsel a draft Coexistence Agreement. While inviting Mr. Larson's proposal for an agreement and acknowledging receipt of Mr. Larson's draft, Applicant's counsel has not engaged in any meaningful discussion on terms nor indicated whether Applicant truly has any interest in reaching such an agreement. Where Mr. Larson has so far attempted to resolve the potential conflict by agreement with Applicant, the instant request for a further extension of 60 days is made so that Mr. Larson may focus his energy on preparing an opposition to the publication of the mark. However, he remains open to an agreement with Applicant if it wishes to discuss amenable terms. Additional time will allow Mr. Larson to prepare and submit an opposition or, alternatively, negotiate a Coexistence Agreement with Applicant.

The time within which to file a notice of opposition is set to expire on 11/27/2013. GlenJ.Larson respectfully requests that the time period within which to file an opposition be extended until 01/26/2014.
