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**By the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board:**

On August 21, 2013, after the appeal was fully briefed, applicant filed a request to divide application Serial No. 85520148, and an Amendment to Allege Use.

On September 16, 2013, the ITU Division completed applicant's request to divide the application as follows:

(1) "Parent" (original) application Serial No. 85520148 contains the following goods "Insulating sleeve holders for beverage cans" in International Class 21; and

(2) Newly created "child" application Serial No. 85980011 contains the following goods: "Food and drink containers for domestic use; portable water carriers, namely, jugs sold empty; portable coolers and jugs of both rigid and fabric construction" in International Class 21.

Exparte Appeal No. 85980011

Because the Amendment to Allege Use, with regard to the goods in the newly created "child" application requires the consideration of the Examining Attorney, application Serial No. 85980011 is remanded to the Examining Attorney.

With respect to the "child" application, if the final refusal is maintained, the examining attorney should issue an Office action and return the application to the Board for resumption of the appeal.

With respect to the "parent" application, Serial No. 85520148, a decision will be rendered in due course.
