**FOURTH REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE BRIEF ON APPEAL**

Applicant respectfully requests that the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board (the “Board”) extend Applicant’s time to file its Appeal Brief for the above-referenced application by an additional sixty days, to and including **November 1, 2016**. Applicant is in active discussions with the owner of the cited registration about a consent agreement and needs additional time to finalize the agreement. Applicant and the owner of the cited registration have exchanged drafts, provided comments, and have been negotiating the wording of one final provision. The owner of the cited registration has been in the process of reorganizing and moving its marks into different entities. The process of finalizing the agreement has been held up until the completion of that project so that the agreement can reflect the proper parties. Counsel for Applicant and the owner of the

cited registration have a phone call scheduled for next week and expect to have a finalized agreement for execution in the near future. Once the consent agreement is finalized and signed, submission of the agreement will allow the TTAB to remand the application, preserving resources in the TTAB.

The above request is not made for the purpose of unduly delaying the proceedings before the Board. Applicant submits that it has demonstrated good cause for this request and respectfully requests that the extension be granted.
