

2. (a) Response and Amendment, dated May 4, 2001, filed in each of Applications Serial No. 75/606,777 (now Registration No. 2,503,414), covering UNIFOCUS and Design, and Serial No. 75/606,778 (now Registration No. 2,503,415), covering UNIFOCUS;

(b) cover letter dated May 4, 2001 from Myers & Associates which accompanied those amendments;

(c) letter from Trademark Trial and Appeal Board, dated September 6 [2001], approving and entering the amendments; and

(d) letter from Trademark Trial and Appeal Board, dated June 3, 2002, indicating that the amendments were inadvertently not entered in the application files, and that amended registrations will be issued.

In its Notice of Reliance dated April 15, 2002, Applicant herein cited a number of third party registrations including Registrations Nos. 2,503,414 (UNIFOCUS and Design) and 2,503,415 (UNIFOCUS), and indicated that the each of these registrations cover computer software in Class 9. However, the applicant in these two cases had filed amendments deleting the Class 9 goods from its applications. The registrations were erroneously issued containing reference to the goods in Class 9.
