On July 1, 2002, applicant filed a revised proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 75/601,010, with opposer's written consent.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to adopt the language indicated in the Board's order of May 28, 2002 and change the identification of services **from** "specialized technical inspection services, namely providing non-destructive technical inspection for assessing anomalies or other defects such as pitting, corrosion, cracking and other like damages in industrial plates, pipes and other materials" **to** "specialized technical inspection services, namely providing non-destructive technical inspection for assessing anomalies or other defects such as pitting, corrosion, cracking and other like damages in industrial plates, pipes

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and other materials, excluding the provision of the above services to the automotive industry."

Inasmuch as the amendment is now clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If this resolves the dispute herein, opposer is allowed until **thirty days** from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c).
