**MOTION FOR ENTRY OF DEFAULT JUDGMENT  
AND BRIEF IN SUPPORT OF MOTION**

Pursuant to TBMP § 508, Opposer brings this motion for entry of a Default Judgment against registration of Application Serial No. 76/004,552. Opposer filed its Notice of Opposition on May 17, 2001. The Trademark Trial and Appeal Board ("The Board") served the Notice of Opposition on Applicant on June 8, 2001 starting this proceeding. A Show Cause Order was issued by the Board on October 9, 2001. To date, Opposer has not received Applicant's Answer to its Notice of Opposition. By telephone inquiry to the Board, Opposer verified that no Answer has been filed by Applicant. Applicant is now in default in this proceeding and Opposer requests that Board enter a Default Judgment in favor of Opposer.

**ARGUMENT**

Opposer is entitled to Default Judgment in this proceeding as no answer has been filed or entered by Applicant. Opposer filed its Notice of Opposition on May 17, 2001.

Applicant did not serve Opposer with an Answer to its Notice of Opposition. Applicant was issued a Show Cause Order on October 9, 2001 and failed to respond to this Order.

Accordingly, Opposer submits that Applicant's failure to serve an Answer in this opposition and proceeding and failure to respond to the Show Cause Order renders the application abandoned. Default Judgment should be entered.

**CONCLUSION**


For good cause shown, Applicant requests that the Board enter a default judgment against Application Serial No. 76/004,552.




