**CONSENTED MOTION FOR CONTINUED

Opposer, INTERFASHION LTD. B.V.I. herewith moves for an Order continuing the suspension of the subject opposition proceeding for an additional period of six months.

It is noted that on March 13, 2004, proceedings were reopened and applicant was given a period of 30 days within which to file an answer to the Notice of Opposition.

Counsel for applicant never received the Notice of Resumption of Proceedings, and accordingly did not timely file an answer to the Notice of Opposition.

In view thereof, applicant requests that there not be any default as a result of not filing of a timely Answer.

Additionally, the parties herewith request that proceedings continue to be suspended for an additional period of six months. This request is made because the parties are continuing to attempt to settle their controversies, and there have been extended delays in arriving at a settlement. This is due in part to the international aspect of this proceeding and the complexity of the anticipated settlement.

Counsel for the opposer has indicated that he has no objection to the continued suspension of the subject proceedings.
