On September 15, 2004, the parties faxed applicant's proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 76073940, with opposer's consent, and opposer's stipulated withdrawal of the opposition, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of services **from**

business information services, namely providing a forum of member system builders, vendors and distributors to exchange information and enhance business through marketing programs, program development, focus groups, newsletter and direct mail, advertisements, product information exchange, technical hotline information services and providing information on discounts to member businesses"

to

business information services in the field of computer system building and integrating, namely, providing a forum of member computer system builders, vendors and distributors to exchange information and enhance business through marketing programs, program development, focus groups, newsletter and direct mail, advertisements,

product information exchange, technical hotline information services and providing information on discounts to member businesses.

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed without prejudice. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c).
