AMENDMENT

Applicant requests that the identification of goods in International Class 7 be amended to read as follows:

-- Rotor blades for wind turbines and parts therefor; housing for wind turbine blades and parts therefor; Rotor blades, structural and replacement parts for wind-powered hydraulic

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turbogenerators; structural and replacement parts for industrial machines made from fiber reinforced plastic.--

No change is requested to the identification of goods in Class 12.

REMARKS

The requested amendment merely adds the words "wind-powered" to the original identification. Applicant and Opposer have agreed to this amendment as part of a settlement of this matter. The requested amendment to the application merely limits the description of goods previously approved and the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board may permit the amendment of the application in accordance with Rule 2.71(a). The parties have agreed that upon acceptance of this amendment by the Patent and Trademark Office, they will stipulate to dismissal of Opposition No. 125,101 with prejudice.
