

other things, the scope of Opposer's rights in the marks in connection with goods and services related to those identified in the registrations.

Finally, the filing of this Notice of Reliance is not intended to waive Opposer's Motion to Extend (filed January 6, 2003) the opening of Opposer's testimony period. Rather, this Notice is filed in an abundance of caution, and inasmuch as the Board has not yet ruled on the pending motion.


