On March 24, 2003, applicant filed a substitute proposed amendment, with proof of service, to its application Serial Nos. 76093512 and 76093513, with opposer's consent.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of services **from** "retail store and mail order services specializing in sheepskin clothing, rugs, automobile accessories and toys" **to** "retail store and mail order services specializing in sheepskin clothing, rugs, toys, and sheepskin automobile accessories, namely, seat covers, seat belt straps, and steering covers" (**Serial No. 76093512**) and **from** "retail store and mail-order services specializing in sheepskin clothing, rugs, automobile accessories, and toys" **to** "retail store and mail orders services specializing in sheepskin clothing, rugs, toys, and sheepskin automobile accessories,

namely, seat covers, seat belt straps, and steering covers, all made of sheepskins" (**Serial No. 76093513**)

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

If this resolves the dispute herein, opposer is allowed until **thirty (30) days** from the mailing date of this order to file a withdrawal of the opposition, failing which the opposition will go forward on the application as amended. See Trademark Rule 2.106(c).
