On July 27, 2006, the Board granted opposer's consented motion to suspend proceedings for settlement negotiations until January 16, 2007. The Board also advised the parties that any further requested extensions and/or suspensions must be accompanied by a recitation of facts constituting good cause for such extensions and/or suspensions.

On January 18, 2007, opposer filed a consented motion to suspend proceedings for settlement negotiations. The Board defers consideration of such motion pending the parties' response to the following.

The parties must file an explanation setting forth facts which constitute good cause for the requested suspension and which complies with the additional requirements established in the Board's July 27, 2006 order (footnote 1) within *thirty days* of the mailing date set forth in the caption above.

Proceedings remain otherwise suspended.
