

Note: Dear Ms. Goodwin: Further to our telephone conversation earlier today and your request, following is a copy of the Express Withdrawal of Application ("Withdrawal") filed on behalf of our client, Applicant Woodruff-Sawyer & Co., on December 31, 2001 (processed by the US Postal Service and the USPTO on January 1, 2002, per date label on our confirmation of receipt card, shown on the copy following).

Our client filed the Withdrawal on December 31, 2001, before receiving notice of Opposition 91150502.

We understand that TBMP Sec. 218, at p. 200-40 provides "...if an applicant files an abandonment after the commencement of an opposition...but before applicant has been notified thereof by the Board, applicant will be given an opportunity to obtain the written consent of every adverse party, or to withdraw the abandonment and litigate...."

Accordingly, we assume the parties will be given notice under TBMP Sec. 218. Thank you for your help.

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
