

(3) Applicant's time to respond or object to Opposer's First Sets of Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents shall be extended to August 4, 2003.

(4) The closing dates of the discovery and testimony periods shall be extended to the following dates:

The period for discovery to close: November 2, 2003

Testimony period for party in
position of plaintiff to close

(opening thirty days prior thereto): January 31, 2004

Testimony period for party in
position of defendant to close

(opening thirty days prior thereto): April 1, 2004

Rebuttal testimony period to close

(opening fifteen days prior thereto): May 16, 2004

The parties are in the process of compiling the information and documents requested by the comprehensive interrogatories, requests for production of documents, and other discovery requests served upon them. Opposer's counsel is dealing

with several sources of information in the United States and abroad, for a period covering many years. This motion is not being made for the purposes of delay, but to permit the parties to respond to the discovery without burdening the Board with motions to compel responses and/or document production.




