**STIPULATION AND ORDER, RESCHEDULING TESTIMONY PERIODS, AND
CLOSING DATE FOR DISCOVERY**

Opposer, and Applicant, in the above-captioned proceeding, by their attorneys, and pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 2.121(d), hereby stipulate that the closing date for discovery shall be extended for an additional period of forty-two (42) days from the period set forth in the Board's *Scheduling Order*, dated August 19, 2002, and the remaining procedural dates shall be reset, so that the revised schedule is as follows:

THE PERIOD FOR DISCOVERY TO CLOSE:	April 18, 2003
30-day period for party in position of plaintiff to close:	July 17, 2003
30-day testimony period for party in position of defendant to close:	September 15, 2003
15-day rebuttal testimony period for plaintiff to close:	October 30, 2003

In each instance, a copy of the transcript of testimony, together with copies of documentary exhibits, must be served on the adverse party within thirty (30) days after completion of the taking of testimony. Trademark Rule 2.125.

Briefs shall be filed in accordance with Trademark Rule 2.128(a) and (b).

An oral hearing will be set only upon request filed as provided by Trademark Rule 2.129.
