**OPPOSER'S BRIEF IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO SUBSTITUTE**

Universal City Studios, Inc. is the opposer of record in this opposition. As shown in Exhibits 1 -3 attached hereto, during May 2002, Universal City Studios, Inc. underwent various corporate conversions and changes of name, ultimately resulting in a successor entity called Universal City Studios LLLP, a Delaware limited liability partnership. Universal City Studios LLLP is the successor-in-interest to Universal City Studios, Inc., and thus owns the trademarks pleaded in this opposition. Copies of the Certificates of Conversion/Change of Name documents were filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office for recordation in November, 2002. Copies of the Recordation Form Cover Sheets are attached hereto in Exhibits 1 through 3.

The conversion/change of name of Universal City Studios, Inc. to Universal City Studios LLLP justifies the substitution of Universal City Studios LLLP for Universal City Studios, Inc. as the party plaintiff in this action under Rule 25 (c) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. See TBMP § 512.02.


**CONCLUSION**
