On February 27, 2003, the parties filed applicant's proposed amendment to its application Serial No. 78/076,494, with opposer's consent, and opposer's withdrawal with prejudice of the opposition, contingent upon entry of the amendment.

By the proposed amendment applicant seeks to change the identification of goods in International Class 12 **from:**

"Motors for cycles, motors for land vehicles, electric motors for land vehicles, transmission shafts for land vehicles, transmissions for land vehicles, windscreen wipers and windshield wipers"

to

"Windscreen wipers and windshield wipers for vehicles."

Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(b), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed with prejudice.¹
